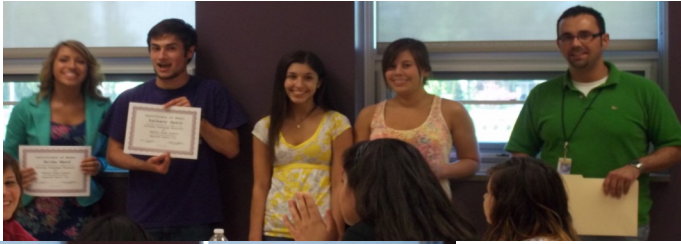

JROTC Cadet Award Banquet Showcases Leaders

Hobart Brickie JROTC recently gathered for their 7th annual cadet award banquet. Over 500 cadets and guests shared an Italian dinner and celebrated a year of cadet success with 28 different awards. Award categories include local and national fitness, academic, leadership, and character awards.

Jimmy Madson and Kaylee Gubricky earned the top fitness awards. Kaylee doubled up earning the top academic award with a 4.0+ cumulative GPA. In fact, 6 other cadets, Kirsten Carlson, Elizabeth Gaines, Kathleen Gaines, Marc Lind, Nolan O'Brien and Josette Torres, also earned awards for 4.0 or higher GPA, 21 for a cumulative 3.0 or higher, and 40 earned Honor Roll status with a semester GPA of 3.0 or higher. Seven cadets earned Perfect Attendance awards with no absences or tardies all year.

Sixteen cadets earned awards for over 100 hours of volunteer service so far during their high school career. Twenty volunteered over 200 hours, and Jacob Hall exceeded 450 hours of volunteer service during his high school career!

Twenty-three cadets were recognized by local and national academic, leadership and military organizations with awards ranging from medals and certificates to plaques and monetary awards.
