Suggested Items to Bring in by Grade Level

- 1st Grade: Canned beans, corn, tuna, crackers, mustard, napkins
- 2nd Grade: Spaghetti, spaghetti sauce, macaroni, rice, cookies, cake mixes
- **3rd Grade**: Canned pork & beans, ketchup, stew, soup jelly, boxed hot or dry cereal
- **4th Grade**: Canned peaches, pears, applesauce, peanut butter, toilet paper, fruit snacks, box dinners
- 5th Grade: Canned juice, fruit cocktail, jars of cheese spread, jello, sugar, paper towels
