SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc. is a growing company dedicated to helping fight teenage drug abuse by assisting schools in setting up student drug testing programs. This successful **Partner Program** provides affordable access to confidential student urine drug testing when requested by parents, while partnering with the parent/guardian to locate necessary help for students identified with drug abuse problems.

SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc. wants to set up a partnership with any parent or guardian to provide this low cost access to drug testing upon the request of the legal parent or guardian.

How the program works!

1. The parent/guardian can obtain the Partner Program **Random Urine Drug Test Requisition Form** from their School Counselor's office.

2. Complete the **Requisition Form** as indicated, read and sign the **Informed Consent and Payment Agreement**. The student also signs this form.

3. When a parent/guardian wishes to have their student drug tested, they simply bring their child with the completed **Requisition Form** to a collection site listed below. Photo ID may be required for identification of the student.

4. The results of the drug testing will be sent directly to Dr. Franz, the Medical Review Officer for **SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc.** Dr. Franz will review the results and certify them as negative or positive then contact the parents.

5. The parent/guardian will be notified by Dr. Franz of any positive result to see if any physician prescribed medication may have caused the positive result. A final written report will be mailed to the parent/guardian. **Results cannot be released to anyone else without written permission of the parent or guardian**.

6. When a positive result occurs, counseling and follow-up options will be presented to the parent/guardian.

7. **SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc.** will bill the parent/guardian for the total cost of requested tests on the **Requisition Form**. Your timely remittence is expected.

8. The parent/guardian will receive another **Requisition Form** when results are sent or they may obtain additional **Partner Program Requisition Forms** from the School Counselor's Office.

This program is available only to enrolled students in grades 7 through 12. There is no attempt to diagnosis any substance abuse problem. **SPORT SAFE Testing Service, Inc.** only wants to assist parents or guardians in making informed decisions on what might need to be done to help their children.

What drugs will be tested for?

The random urine specimens may be tested for the following illicit drugs or banned substances:

Alcohol Amphetamines Anabolic Steroids Barbiturates Benzodiazepines (Valium) Cocaine LSD Marijuana Methadone Ecstasy Nicotine (Tobacco) Opiates (Codeine) Phencyclidine Propoxyphene (Darvon)

Warning Signs of Drug Abuse!

School Setting Behaviors:

♦ Truancy

- \diamond Verbal and Physical Abuse toward staff or classmates
- ♦ Vandalism
- ♦ Absenteeism
- ♦ Sudden Drop in Grades

Other Classroom signs include:

✓ Bloodshot eyes (pot).

- ✓ Smell.
- ✓ Lack of Responsiveness.
- ✓ Lots of talk about drugs or alcohol.
- ✓ Defensive behavior.
- ✓ Leaving the room often.
- ✓ Incomplete assignments.
- ✓ Dress (e.g., roach clips, T-shirts with slogans about drugs).
- ✓ Forged notes from home.
- ✓ Giving in to peer pressure

Other Noticeable Signs:

- ♦ Changing Circle of Friends.
- \diamond Undergoing emotional highs and lows.
- \Rightarrow Defying rules and regulations.
- ♦ Showing frustration and giving in to peer pressure.
- \diamond Sleeping more than usual.
- ♦ Withdrawing from family functions.
- ♦ Changing to worse physical hygiene.
- ♦ Isolating self.
- \diamond Developing a short temper.
