First Registration

How will I know how much money is in my child's lunch account? You can call the café staff and ask. They will also send you a print out so that you can see what snacks your child is buying. You can request that your child, for example, only has one snack two times a week, and that information will be added to your child's account.

Can I eat lunch in the Café? You are welcome anytime. However, we encourage you to come infrequently. This is a time for your child to make new friends and enjoy conversation with their peers.
