The School City of Hobart utilizes the SchoolMessenger/Skylert notification service to send you phone and text messages to provide you with important information about school events or emergencies. We will utilize SchoolMessenger/Skylert to notify you of school delays or cancellations due to inclement weather, as well as remind you about various events, including report card distribution, open houses, field trips, and more. In the event of an emergency at school, you can have peace of mind knowing that you will be informed immediately by phone.

Attendance

Excellent attendance is very important. There are many learning opportunities occurring in class that cannot be reproduced at home, such as class discussions, small group collaboration, and hand-on experiences. Please emphasize daily attendance and arriving at school on time with your child.

However, we don't want students who are truly sick at school. You can help us by doing the following:

- Keep your child home if s/he is sick. When you call your child off, please report the type of illness and/or symptoms.
- Teach your child to wash hands often with soap and water for 20 seconds, the amount of time it takes to sing Happy Birthday. Be a good example yourself!
- Teach your child to cover coughs and sneezes with tissues or by coughing into the inside of his or her own elbow.
- A child who is sick should stay home from school and avoid people until s/he is better.
- When your child is free of a fever for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medications like Tylenol, s/he can return to school.
- Please remember to send a note or doctor's note that includes your child's full name, date(s) of absence, and reason.
