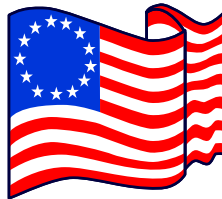
JUNE 29 MEETING NOTES: by J. Deal **SONG:** National Anthem led by Cas
